# **CSIR-PGRPE-2010: Short-Listing Result for**

# "Advanced Semiconductor Electronics" Programme at CEERI, Pilani

#### **General Conditions:**

- 1. Engineering graduates of 2009 and the candidates graduating in 2010 have been considered.
- 2. The age cannot be more than 25 years (for general and OBC category) and 28 years (for SC/ST category) as on 01.07.2010.
- 3. CGPA has been converted to equivalent percentage by a linear method which converts the highest possible CGPA in the system to 100% on the percentage scale
- 4. Result awaited candidates were considered provisionally based on their performance up to 7th semester.
- 5. CGPA of 7.00 (out of 10) or 70% marks is necessary for being eligible for the programme.

# **Short-listing Criteria:**

The applicant needs to fulfill any one of the criteria listed in the table below in order to be eligible for appearing in interview.

S. No.	Criteria	Applicable Candidates
1.	CGPA >= 9.26 or Percentage >= 92.60%	All candidates.
2.	CGPA >= 8.76 or Percentage >= 87.60%	SC/ST/PH category candidates.
3.	GATE Score >= 754	All candidates with <i>valid</i> GATE score.
4.	GATE Score >= 724	SC/ST/PH category candidates with <i>valid</i> GATE score.
5.	CGPA >= 7.50 or Percentage >= 75.00%	Graduates of IITs, IT-BHU, ISMU, and BITS-Pilani.

Any applicant who fulfills the short-listing criteria mentioned above but whose name does not appear in the list of short-listed candidates for interview may communicate immediately by email giving complete details to <pgrpe@ceeri.ernet.in>. If the claim is found valid, the candidate will be allowed to attend the interview with all valid documents on July 09, 2010 or July 10, 2010.

## **Instructions and Information for Short-Listed Candidates**

Short-listed candidates are required to appear for interview to be held at INSA Building, Bahadur Shah Zafar Marg, New Delhi – 110 002 as per the schedule given in list of the short-listed candidates

(Candidates must get their documents verified by reporting one hour before the starting time of the interview. Unsuccessful verification will make a candidate ineligible for appearing for the interview)

- July 7, 2010; 10.00 AM to 1.30 PM : Candidates at serial numbers from 1 to 20.
- July 7, 2010; 2.30 PM to 6.00 PM : Candidates at serial numbers from 21 to 40.
- July 8, 2010; 10.00 AM to 1.30 PM: Candidates at serial numbers from 41 to 60.
- July 8, 2010; 2.30 PM to 6.00 PM: Candidates at serial numbers from 61 to 80.
- July 9, 2010; 10.00 AM to 1.30 PM: Candidates at serial numbers from 81 to 100.
- July 9, 2010; 2.30 PM to 6.00 PM : Candidates at serial numbers from **101 to 120.**
- July 10, 2010; 10.00 AM to 1.30 PM: Candidates at serial numbers from 121 onwards.
- July 10, 2010; 2.30 PM to 3.30 PM : Any other eligible candidates.

Any candidate whose name does not appear in the list of candidates short-listed for interview, but who fulfills the shortlisting criteria is requested to appear for the interview with valid documents on July 09, 2010 or July 10, 2010 with prior information.

## Documents to be brought by the candidates at the time of Interview:

Candidates are required to bring following documents at the time of appearing for the interview:

- 1. Two printed copies of the submitted application form of each programme preference.
- 2. Two copies of their recent passport size photograph for each programme preference.
- 3. Originals along with two photocopies for each programme preference of each of the following documents:
- (a) BE/BTech/B.Sc.(Engineering) degree / provisional degree.
- (b) BE/BTech/B.Sc.(Engineering) detailed marksheet(s) / transcripts showing the final CGPA/percentage upto eight semesters / 4 years or CGPA/percentage upto seventh semester (where final results have not yet been announced).
- (c) Matriculation/secondary school certificate (in support of date of birth).
- (d) SC/ST/OBC/PH candidates are also required to produce the requisite certificate issued by the competent authority.
- (e) Valid GATE score card of GATE-2010 examination, if applicable.
- (f) Diploma Pass certificate, if applicable.

### Other Information:

- 1. Selection of the candidates will be based on their performance in the interview.
- 2. Candidates admitted provisionally to the CSIR-PGRPE programme based on their CGPA/percentage results up to 7<sup>th</sup> semester (pending availability of final result) would have to furnish their final result and percentage/CGPA on or before October 31, 2010 for confirmation of their provisional admission. If they are unable to do so or if their final percentage/CGPA falls below *the basic eligibility criteria*, *their provisional admission will stand cancelled*.

Fellowship as Quick Hire Scientists (QHS) for provisionally admitted candidates will be released only after confirmation of their provisional admissions.

- 3. No TA/DA would be payable to candidates for attending the interviews.
- 4. Note that on joining the programme, all successful candidates will be eligible for journey TA as well as TA/DA for attending the interview.
